Step by Step Procedure of using Fire Extinguishers and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) was also demonstrated through videos. In the third portion participants themselves practically extinguished Class A and Class B fire using CO<sub>2</sub> and DCP Fire Extinguishers on the roof top.
