CIRCULAR (SUMMER SEMESTER-2022)

As per regulations laid down in the Rules and Regulations (Undergraduate Programs), the Bachelor's Degree Programme is spread over four academic years (Eight Regular Semesters) while the maximum duration is seven years. Each academic year consists of two regular teaching semesters i.e., Fall and Spring and an optional Summer Semester.

A. Regulations

The relevant rules governing the Summer Semester are reproduced as under:

- Summer Semester shall be primarily for those students who want to repeat/improve certain courses to make up for their academic deficiencies.
- An academically deficient student, either regular or casual, shall be allowed to get himself registered for maximum of 21 credit hours, provided that contact hours also does not exceed total number of available work hours per week.
- The minimum strength to offer a course in Summer Semester will be Five students. However, the competent authority may relax the condition of five students on recommendations of the Chairman of the concerned academic department only for graduating and casual students. In case if such course is offered, it will be open for registration to other students as well. Fee as prescribed by the university will be charged from all such registered students.
- Teaching shall be mandatory for all offered courses in Summer Semester.
- The contact hours during the Summer Semester shall be doubled to ensure that the course is completely taught in a Summer Semester with half of the duration compared to regular semester.
- Letter Grade awarded during Summer Semester shall not be more than a "B" grade. Also, no "I" grade will be awarded in summer semester.
- The registration, attendance, conduct of examination and result display policies etc. during the Summer Semester shall be same as in regular semester.
- It shall be in the best interest of the students to clear their failed courses or the courses where they want to improve their grades by repeating the courses as early as possible. The University will not be responsible to offer failed or improvement courses in the final year unless and until the other conditions of Summer Semester registration are fulfilled.

B. Schedule

Duration of Summer Semester	:	04-07-2022 to 09-09-2022 (Including Eid-ul-Zaha Holidays)
Registration & Fee Deposit	:	20-06-2022 to 01-07-2022
Commencement of Classes	:	04-07-2022
Examinations/Assessment	:	05-09-2022 to 09-09-2022

- The registration will be done on ERP portal and must be closed before 30-07-2022 in all aspects.
- All regular and casual students of Chakwal campus are allowed to register their courses in their relevant departments in the main campus of the UET Taxila as per decision of academic council 45/2022 dated 30-04-2022.
- Overlapping of semester is strictly banned by PEC and HEC.
- The registration fee @ Rs. 2000/- per credit hour plus Rs. 1000/- examination fee will be required to be deposited by the candidates along with the Summer Semester Registration Form (as per decision of Syndicate meeting 54/2020 dated 25-07-2020).
- An academically deficient student having 'F' Grade in any course will be eligible for registration if the same course is offered. Also, a student having "D" and "C-" grades can register himself to improve the grade.
- As soon as a student is registered for a course, his better grade earned by the student shall be considered for the computation of **CGPA**.
